

# The Eucharist, and the sacrament!



The Eucharist, the sacrament of the Lord's Supper; the Communion; the sacrifice of the Mass. **The consecrated elements** of the Lord's Supper, especially **the bread!** The giving of thanks and gratefulness describe the Eucharist.

The sacrament! The sacraments of the Protestant Churches are baptism and the Lord's Supper. The sacraments of the Roman and Greek Catholic Churches are baptism, confirmation, the Eucharist, matrimony, penance, holy orders, and extreme unction i.e. anointing. Definitions from a College Dictionary!

1 Corinthians 11:24, 25, and 27 through 32.

24. And when he had given thanks, he brake *it*, and said, **Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me.**

25. After the same manner also *he took* the cup, when he had supped, saying, **This cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink *it*, in remembrance of me.**

27. Wherefore whosoever shall eat this bread, and drink this cup of the Lord, **unworthily**, shall be guilty of **the body** and **blood of the Lord**. Compare the **worthy** within Luke 21:36.

28. But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup.

29. For he that eats and drinks **unworthily**, eats and drinks **damnation** to himself, **not discerning the Lord's body**.

1 Corinthians 2:12, Rev. 3:10 and 14:17-20!

30. For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and **many sleep**.

**For ever!**  
Isaiah 66:22, 23!

31. For if we would judge ourselves, we should not be judged.

Instructed, taught, disciplined

32. **But when we are judged, we are chastened** of the Lord, that we should not **be condemned with the world**. See Hebrews 12:7 and 8!

**be condemned**

Exodus 31:12 through 18 read them all!

14. You shall keep **the Sabbath** therefore; for **it is holy** unto you: every one that defiles it shall surely be **put to death**: for whosoever does any work therein, that soul shall be cut off from among his people. 17. It is **a sign** between me and the children of Israel **for ever**: for in six days the Lord made heaven and earth, and on **the seventh day**, he rested, and was refreshed. See Hebrews 8 and 10:15, 16! **S M T W T F S → Saturday!**

**John 14:15 and 21 through 24**  
15. If you love me, keep my commandments.

21. He that has **my commandments**, and keeps them, he it is that **loves me**: and he that **loves me** shall **be loved** of my Father, and I will **love him**, and will manifest myself to him.

22. Judas said unto him, not Iscariot, Lord, how is it that you will manifest yourself unto us, and not unto the world?

See Matthew 7:21 through 23!

23. Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man **love me**, he will **keep my words**: and **my Father** will love him, and **we** will come unto him, and make **our** abode with him.

24. He that loves me **not** keeps **not my sayings**: and the word which you hear is not mine, but the Father's which sent me. See John 12:49, Acts 13:27, 42, 44, 16:13, 17:2, 18:4 and 21.
